#### **Investment Objective**

The investment objective of the Cantor Fitzgerald High Income Fund (the "Fund") is to obtain high current income. The Fund pursues its objective by investing at least 80% of net assets in income producing securities, and as much as 100% in high-yield, lower rated or unrated debt securities.





#### **Definitions**

Holdings refer to the individual bonds or debt securities that make up the fund's portfolio. These holdings are the actual assets in which the fund has invested. Effective Duration measures change in the value of a security in response to a change in interest rates. Weighted Average Maturity refers to the average time it takes for all the bonds within a portfolio to mature, where each bond's maturity is weighted by its proportion of the total portfolio value. 12-Month Default Rate represents the percentage of bonds outstanding and/or held that have defaulted over the previous 12-month period. 30-Day SEC yield is a mutual fund's yield, calculated as required by the SEC, based on the earnings of the fund's portfolio during a 30-day period, divided by the offering price per share at the end of the period. This calculation reflects an estimated yield to maturity. It should be regarded as an estimate of the fund's rate of investment income, and it may not equal the fund's actual income distribution rate. Standard Deviation measures that an investment will fluctuate from its expected return. The smaller an investment's standard deviation, the less volatile it is considered to be. Conversely, the larger the standard deviation, the more volatile the investment. Downside Capture measures manager's performance in down markets. A down-market is defined as those periods (months or quarters) in which market return is less than 0. Beta is a measure of systematic risk with respect to a benchmark. Beta measures the sensitivity of the fund's excess return (total return minus the risk-free return) with respect to the benchmark's excess return that results from their systematic co-movement. The beta of the market is 1.00 by definition.
